Can I organize with Automatic Organizer my archives?

It will not just sort archives by creation date - is will view and analyze their content, according to which and archive processing rules, that you can easily specify, it will rename archive and append it to archives database, or extract archive content and process each of files inside of archive separately. This possibility may be very useful, for example, if you have archives with music files inside - it can process all music files in archives and add them to your music library.
